



On April 5th 2019, Thailand Greenhouse Gas Management Organization (TGO) organized a seminar titled “How to apply for financial support for developing greenhouse gas emission reduction project under the Joint crediting Mechanism (JCM)”. JCM is a bilateral mechanism between Thailand and Japan. JCM facilitates diffusion of leading low carbon technologies, products, systems, services, and infrastructure as well as implementation of mitigation actions, and contributes to sustainable development of developing countries. The objectives of the seminar are to inform private companies on how to get the financial support from Ministry of Environment, Japan to develop JCM project and timeline for submission of proposal. It was an honor that representatives from many companies joined the seminar. The total number of participants is 56 people from 26 companies. Survey of technologies that private companies want to get support was conducted. The results will be conveyed to the Ministry of Environment, Japan for the promotion of development of JCM projects in Thailand.
