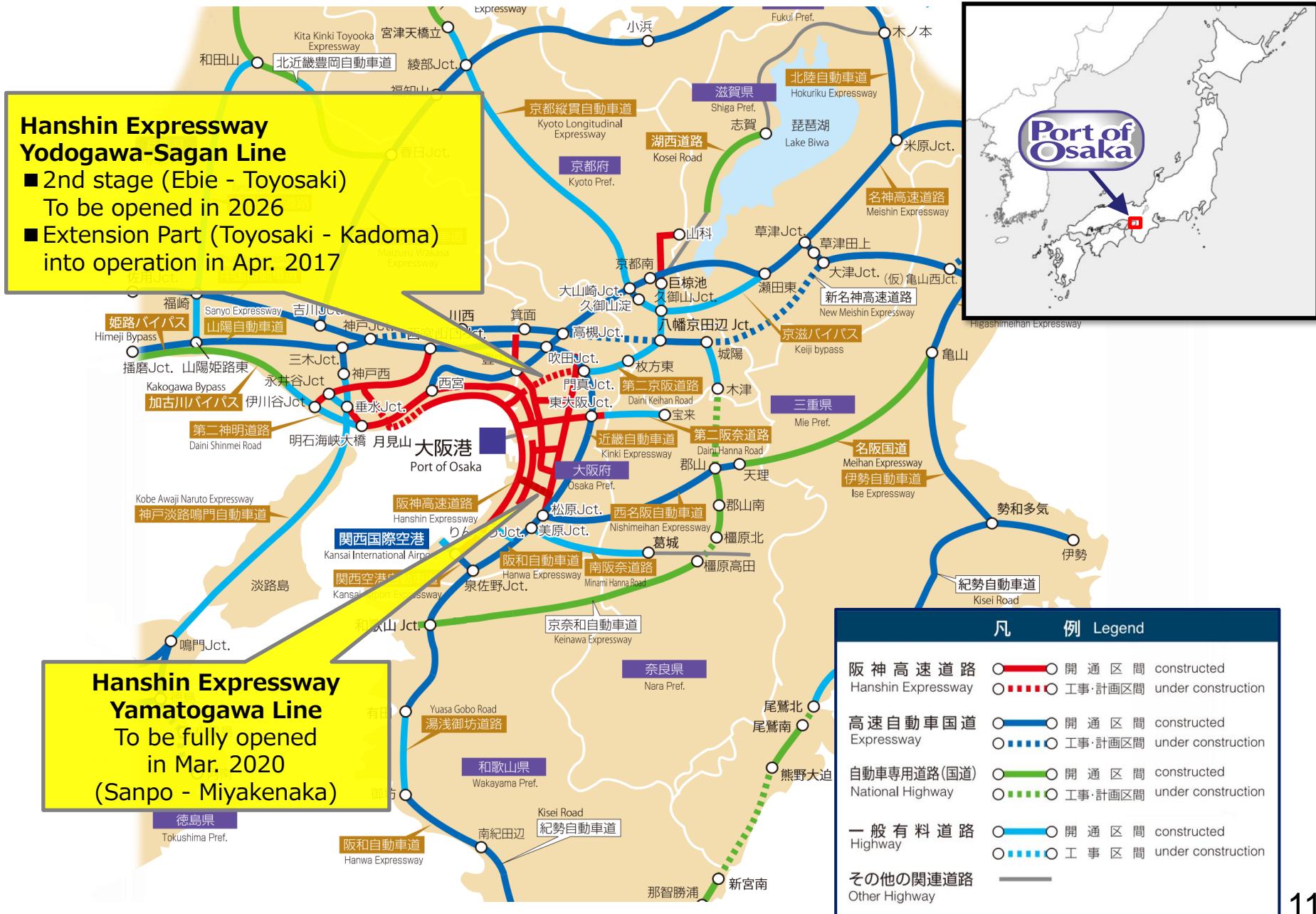

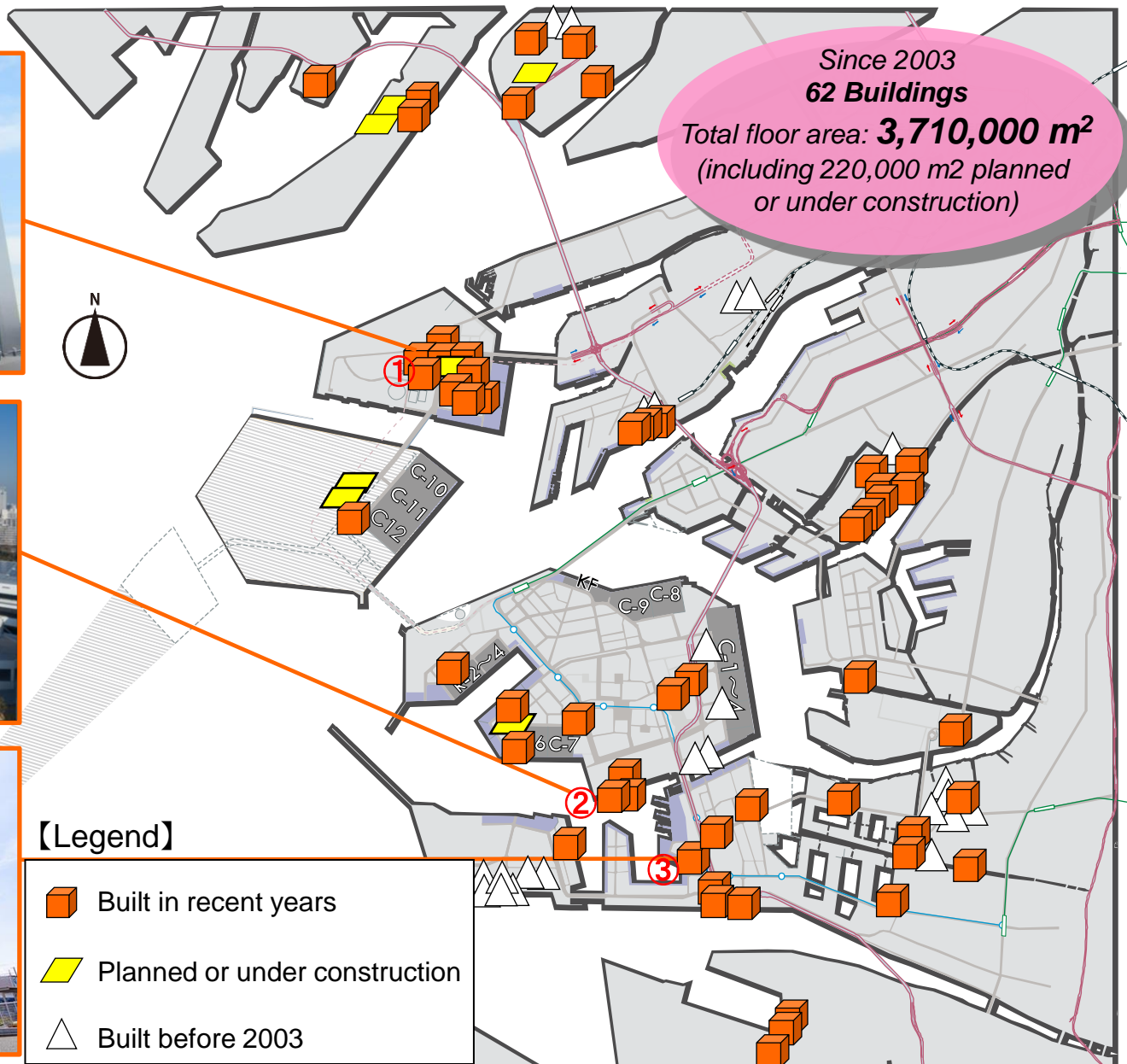
Highway network around the Port of Osaka

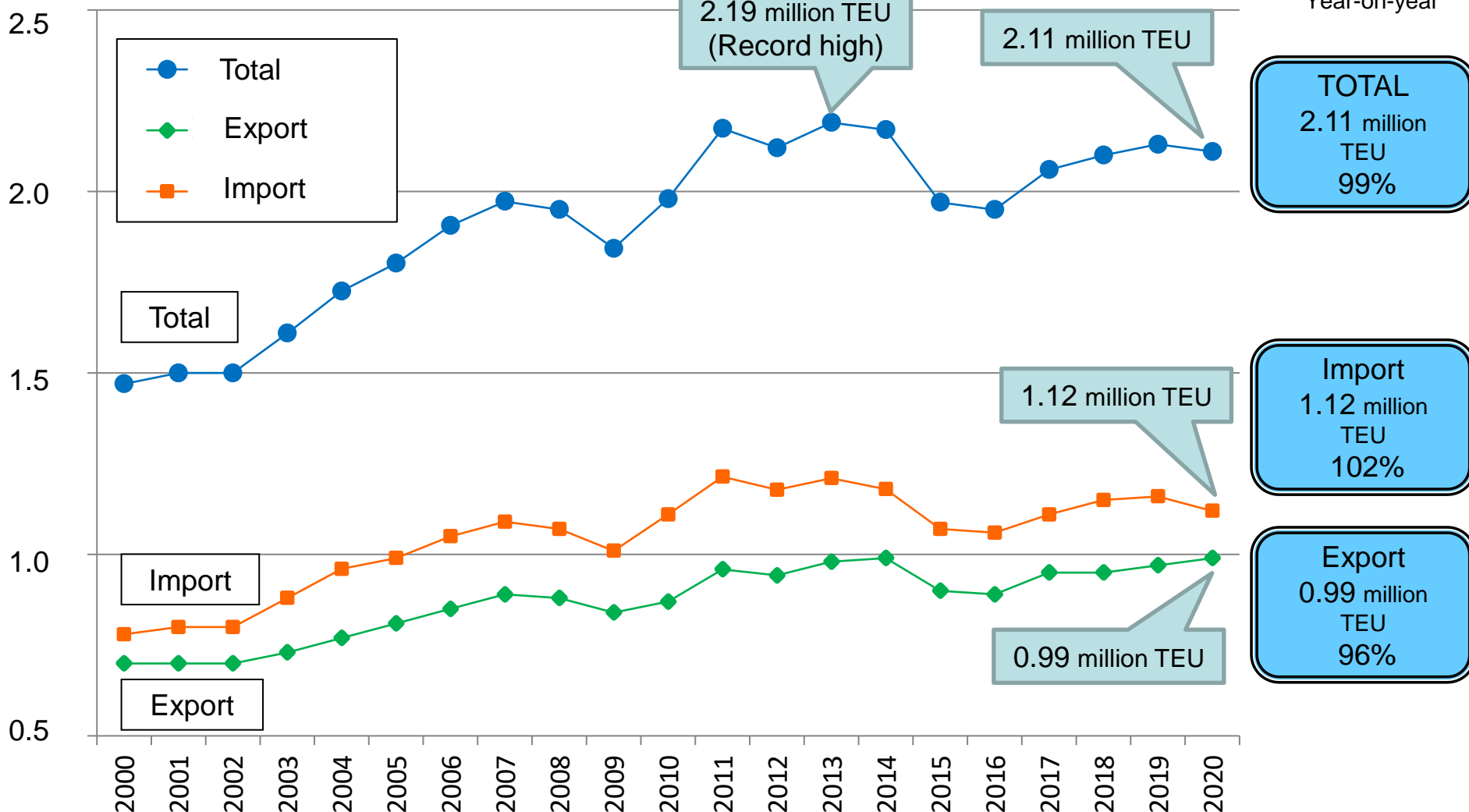

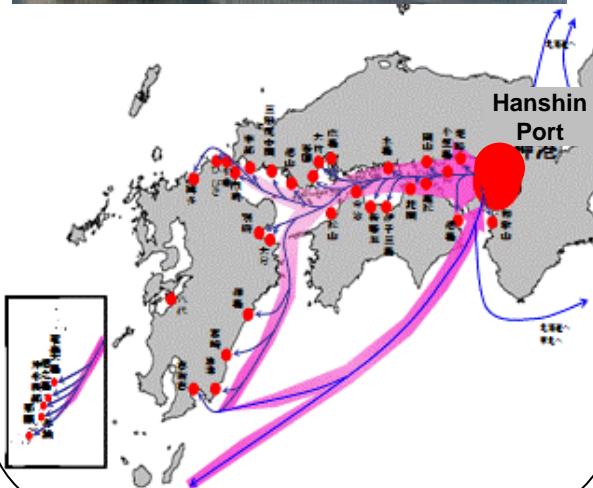


Osaka Port's strategy for the Strategic International Container Port

① Collection of cargoes

■ Further improvement of cargo collection networks

- Undertaking projects to attract cargoes and conducting port sales activities



② Creation of cargoes

■ Promotion of exporting “sho-ku” (which means “food”)

- Supporting logistics system for expanding exports of agricultural and fishery products

③ Strengthening the competitiveness

■ Strengthening the functions of port facilities

- Improvement and expansion of container terminals in response to the increasing size of container ships

■ Expanding of Container Terminals in Yumeshima
 Berth Length: 1,350m
 Berth Depth : -15m ~ -16m
 Yard Area : 59ha ⇒ 74ha
 Scheduled to be completed in FY2024



■ Dredging to deepen the main channel
 Width : 400m ⇒ 560m
 Depth : -15m ⇒ -16m
 Scheduled to be completed in FY2026

Summary

- ◆ Osaka : Japan's 2nd largest city / (Future) World Expo 2025, etc.
- ◆ Port of Osaka : Extensive port facilities and route services
 - ➡ Plays a vital role as an international logistics hub
- ◆ Projects undertaken by the Port of Osaka : Development of facilities, sales promotion, etc.
 - ➡ Promotion of the use of the Port of Osaka, partnership with the Port of J. Nehru
 - ➡ Increase in the handled cargo amount of, and establishment and enhancement of routes between, the two ports
